ORNAMENTAL CROSS FOR MAIN BRIDGE, PHILIPPINES

CASE STUDY

ESC Philippines takes pride and prestige in its partaking in the fabrication and supply of steel structures for the construction of a monumental infrastructure project in Cebu, the quincentennial cross. The quincentennial cross is an ornamental stainless steel cross for an iconic bridge project in Cebu in time for the celebration of 500 years of Christianity in the Philippines.

This project was inspired by the cross planted by Portuguese explorer Ferdinand Magellan in Cebu 500 years ago. It was a three dimensional eight (8) giant stainless 316L cross with 40 meters tall with all sides of the 2 main pylon on the bridge.

It is produced and fabricated by cold forming a tapered C-section of 12mm thickness plate on the vertical portion while the horizontal section was welded with the highest and tight tolerances to meet client standard. The ornamental stainless steel cross is considered to be a significant icon as it symbolizes role as the cradle of the Christianity in the city and country.

This is indeed a proud moment not only for the ESC Philippines team but for the whole ESC group as well, whose efforts are reshaping the construction industry. ESC Group is deeply honoured not just of being a part in the commemoration of a historical chapter of the nation but also in being a part of this monumental project that will surely bring a huge socioeconomic impact especially in the Visayan Region.
